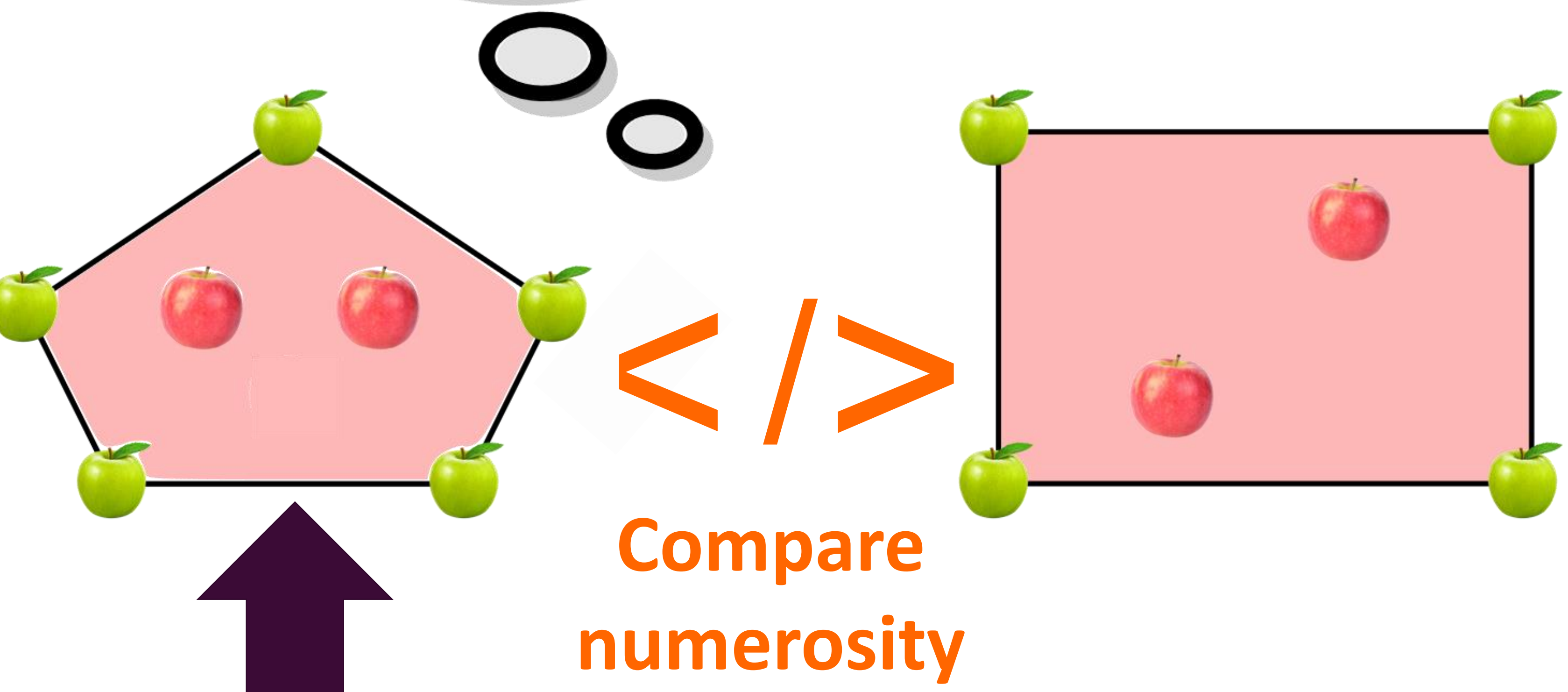


Shape affects numerical comparisons, although (seemingly) irrelevant to the task

Max Probability = P (Number | Shape)

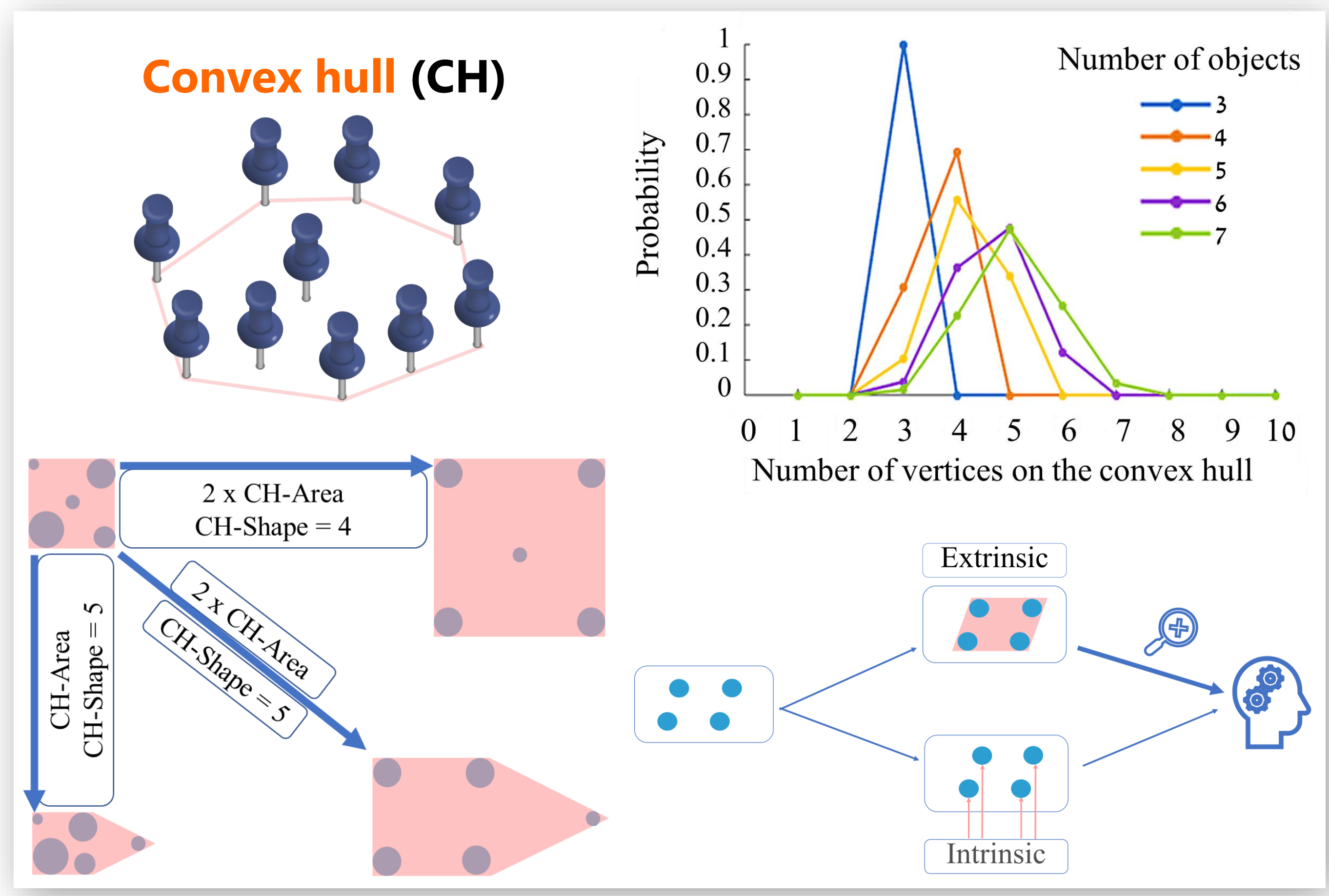


Use shape - convex hull probability

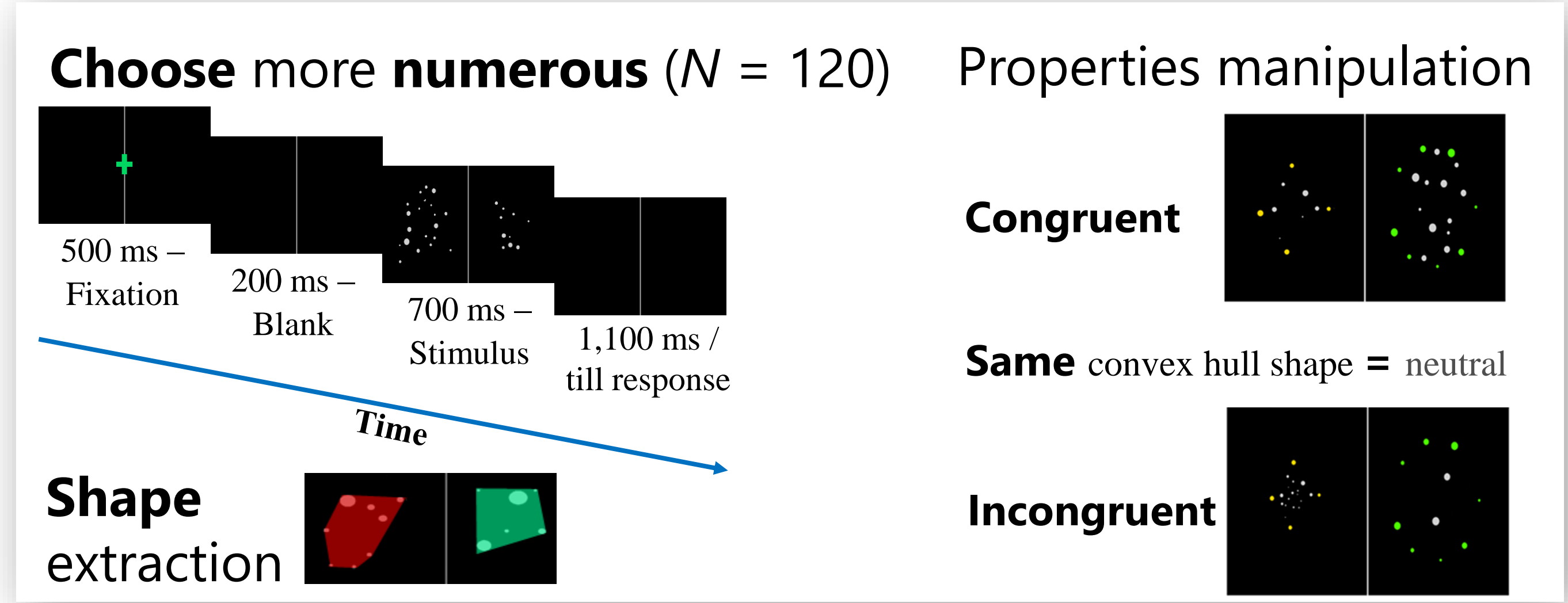
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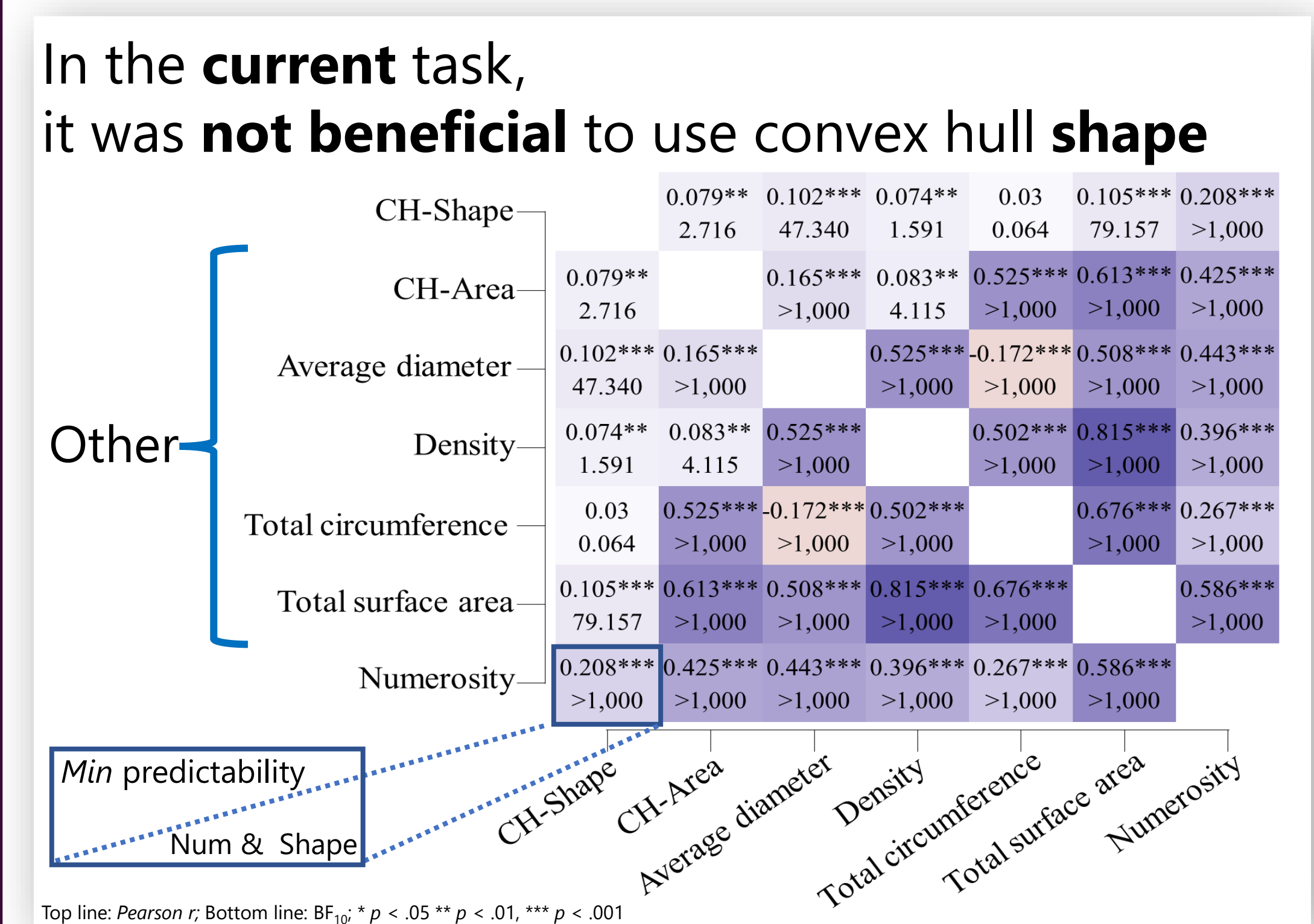

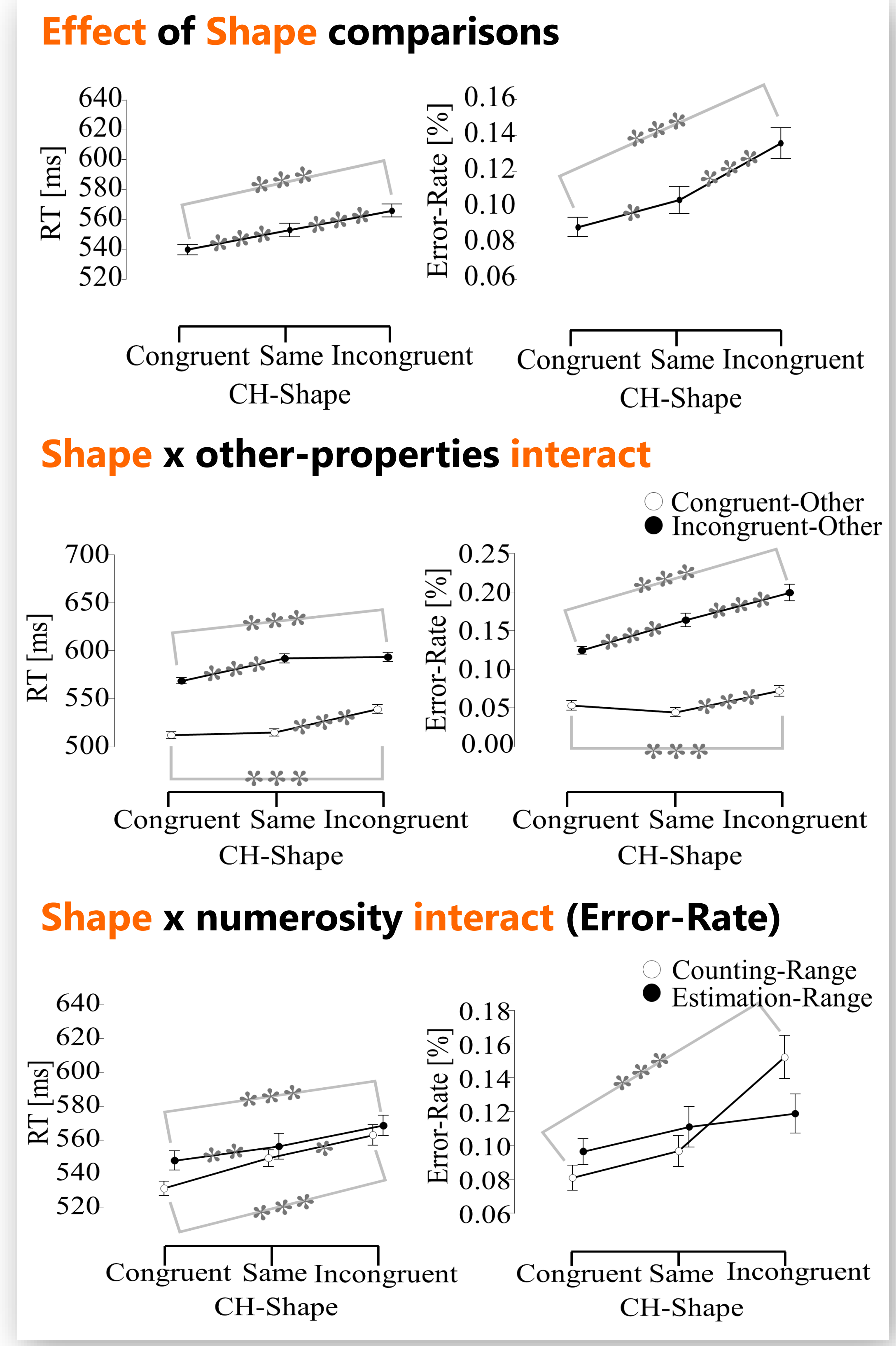
