Claude (Dov) B. Stuczynski is an Assistant Professor at the Department of History (Bar-Ilan University). Having written a number of General contributions in various languages (books: The New Christians in Portugal in the 20th century in Hebrew and in French, "Between Religion and Religiosity. Converso Judaizers of Braganca and the Inguisition of Coimbra in the 16th century"; "In Defense of the Nation: Portuguese Converso Apologetics in the 17th century", forthcoming and "Conquistadores' Consciousness, Fray Bartolome de Las Casas and his Defense of the Amerindians", forthcoming in Hebrew), his two main fields of research are: the Converso phenomenon mainly in Portugal- and Early Modern encounters between Europeans and non Europeans- mainly Amerindians. He is interested in the relationship between religion and politics in Medieval and Early Modern periods. Actually he prepares a study of the theological-political dimension of the Converso phenomenon (what he calls: "The Marrano Paulinian Moment"). last year he taught at Tel-Aviv University and is a current board member of the Center for the Study of Conversions within Abrahamic Religions at Ben-Gurion University, Beer-Sheva.
