Prof. Jasbir Dhaliwal is L.W. Papasan Professor of Information Systems and Associate Dean for Research and Academic Programs at the University of Memphis.

He is also the founding director of the Systems Testing Excellence Program (STEP) at the university's FedEx Institute of Technology. STEP represents the largest interdisciplinary group of academic researchers working to advance both the theoretical science of software testing and empirically validated best-practices in industry. It serves as the research and training partner of the Global Testing Center of Excellence at FedEx Corporation and also undertakes projects for the Department of Defense, Wells Fargo Bank, Nomura Japan, and many other technology companies.

Starting with his early work in the late 80's on the validation of artificial intelligence systems, Prof. Dhaliwal has published more than seventy research articles and made numerous keynote and other presentations to industry audiences all over the world. His recent ideas about software testing have been presented at STAREAST and the International Conference on Software Testing while his latest research on systems testing is published in the European Journal of Information Systems, the Journal of Strategic Information Systems, IEEE Software and the Journal of Database Management.

He also serves as a technical advisor for software quality to several large technology organizations in North America, Europe and Asia.

His PhD is from the University of British Columbia in Canada and he is active as an angel investor in technology start-ups from his home in Germantown, TN.
