Candidates must submit their requests for the scholarship after registering for their Msc studies. Unregistered candidates will not be considered by the scholarship Committee.

Students already enrolled in the M.Sc program having exceptional proved achievements may also apply and will be considered based on funds availability.

C. Criteria for the granting of the scholarship

- 1. Proven excellence in their previous studies, and in industry (if relevant)
- 2. Excellent grades in prior degrees.
- 3. Outstanding achievements in research.

Obligations of scholarship recipients

Scholarship recipients make the following commitments to the University:

- a) To complete their research work within 2 years from the date of their acceptance into the M.Sc. studies or, in the case of the direct track, within 3 years.
- b) In cases in which these studies are stopped before the MSc. is granted, the scholarship is to be refunded.
- c) Presenting their research at a meeting with KLA-Tencor.
