



KTI Scholarship for Excellence Ph.D. students beginning their studies in electro-optics and photonics engineering

A. General

The scholarship is provided by: KLA-Tencor Israel (KTI) to promote enrollment of excellent students to study PhD in Electro-Optics and Photonics Engineering

These scholarship is intended in 1st priority for new students entering the 2018-2019 academic year. Students with exceptional achievements in their 1st or 2nd year might also apply and will be considered on 2nd priority bases depending on the availability of funds.

Scholarships up to 7000\$ will be granted based on excellence

Submission of candidacy for additional scholarship:

B. Conditions for submitting candidacy

These Scholarships are intended for incoming doctoral students beginning their PhD studies in Electro-Optics and Photonics Department for the 2018-2019 academic year fully dedicated to their studies. Candidates must submit their requests for the scholarship after registering for their doctoral studies. Unregistered candidates will not be considered by the Scholarship Committee.

C. Criteria for the granting of a scholarship

1. Outstanding achievements in research.
2. Proven excellence in the past.
3. Excellent grades in prior degrees.

D. Guidelines for the submission of candidacy

The request, in the form of a PDF file, must be submitted to electrop@bgu.ac.il and must include:

1. Curriculum Vitae.



2. A list of publications. Mention the impact factor (IF) and ranking of the journals in which the papers were published, if relevant.

Example:

L. Gao, J. Liang, C. Li, and L. V. Wang, "Single-shot compressed ultrafast photography at one hundred billion frames per second," *Nature* 516, 74-77 (2014). (IF 41.577; Journal ranking 1/64; Q1). [Link to article](#)

3. List of submitted papers, including the abstract and the details of the journal as described above.
4. List of conference papers, id relevant
5. Grade sheets from the first and second degrees.
6. Names and email addresses of two referees.

Submission deadline: 30 Nov. 2018

Obligations of the scholarship recipients

Scholarship recipients make the following commitments to the University:

- a) To complete their research work within 4 years from the date of their acceptance into the doctoral studies or, in the case of the direct track, within 5 years.
- b) In cases in which these studies are stopped before the Ph. D. is granted, the Scholarship is to be refunded.
- c) Presenting their research at a meeting with KLA-Tencor.
