

Professor Michael Bar-Eli holds the Nat Holman Chair in Sports Research and is the former Chair of the Business Administration Department at the Faculty of Business and Management, Ben-Gurion University of the Negev, Beer-Sheva, Israel. At The Academic College at Wingate, he is Chairperson of both the Supreme Academic Council and the Supreme Appointments (Promotion) Committee. Bar-Eli earned degrees in psychology and sociology from universities in Israel and Germany. He has over 200 refereed publications in English and numerous publications in Hebrew. Bar-Eli also provides editorial services to leading international and Israeli scientific journals. He held senior psychology positions in the Israel Defense Forces and serves as a consultant in elite sports. Bar-Eli has held senior positions in FEPSAC (The European Federation of Sport Psychology) and ASPASP (The Asian-South Pacific Association of Sport Psychology). His scientific work has been recognized by a number of awards, such as “Mercator Professor” at the University of Tuebingen, “Distinguished Invited Professor” at Heidelberg University, and “ASPASP Fellow”.
