שם הקורס: פוליטיקה, חברה ומשפט בהודו המודרנית

מטרות הקורס:

קורס זה עוסק בחקר סכסוגים ובניטוח הדינמיקה הפוליטית בדמוקרטיה היהודית, הדמוקרטיה הגדולה וההמגונת ביותר בעולם. במהלך הקורס נתמקד בחקר סוגיות מרכזיות בתחום הממשלה, והפוליטיקה בהודו לאחר השיטעים הדתיים, אתניים, לשוניים, מגדריים, מעמדיים וازוריים המקיימים בה, וכן ביחסים החוצים שלה עם שכנותיה. הקורס יתמקד בחקר הפוליטיקה של הודו העצמאית (1947-1947 ואילך), בפרשנטיבית תיאורית והשוואתית. במסגרת הקורס הסטודנטים ירכשו כלים לגבי ניתוח מקורה מבחן, בנוסף לידע אודוט מקרה המבחן היהודי.
