## **Further Instructions for the Conferment Ceremony of Doctoral Degrees**

- 1. Degree recipients will be fitted with a cap and gown in the fitting room prior to the ceremony.
- 2. The procession order and the order in which graduates are called up to the stage will be in accordance with the list appearing in the event invitation.
- 3. During the ceremony, the moderator will call your name and invite you to the stage to receive your diploma from the Rector, the Dean of the Kreitman School, and the Dean of your Faculty. While on stage, please be sure to pause for a moment, so that the photographer can capture this important moment.
- 4. Please take care to follow the names as they are read out. When the name before yours is called, proceed to the stairs below the stage and wait there. Once your name is called, go up on to the stage from the right and descend from the left. After receiving your diploma, return to your seat.
- 5. For graduates who will not be attending the ceremony: Diplomas of graduates who are not present at the ceremony may be given to family members. You may contact Michal Rokni at the Kreitman School (<u>mrokni@bgu.ac.il</u>) to arrange to pick up your diploma at a later date.
- 6. The master of ceremonies will ask you all to rise when the Rector reads the Writ of Conferment.
- 7. After the ceremony, you are requested to return the cap and gown to the fitting room.
- 8. As noted, the ceremony will be photographed by the University Photographer. A link to the event photo gallery will be sent to you shortly thereafter.
