There is a large quantity of online materials available for instruction and for writing papers. Please update your students and encourage them to begin their research while they have the time.

Scanning book chapters and journal articles from the library's print collection – Our staff will continue scanning and sending materials from the library's physical collection, to fill instructors' distance teaching. If possible, we will scan and send you the material you need for the semester. Please send you requests to yaatz@bgu.ac.il

Be aware: We cannot scan an entire book, only selected chapters. You can upload scanned material to Moodle as needed for current lessons, delete the material when it is no longer in use, and replace it with additional chapters. At the end of the semester, you need to delete the material in order not to violate copyright restrictions.

Ordering books - Please send your lists of books for purchase to your contact librarian (as usual). At the current time preference is, of course, for e-book editions. We will make every effort to provide electronic access as quickly as possible. Print books will arrive when we have returned to regular service.

Access to electronic resources - If there are special requests for access during the semester, please notify me, and I will try to arrange a trial period or temporary free access.
