

Dr. Tom Pessah is a sociologist specializing in the area of ethnic violence. He received his B.A. and M.A. at Tel Aviv University, where he also completed a degree in General History. His Ph.D, which he completed at the University of California, Berkeley, in 2014, focuses on internal debates regarding ethnic cleansing within settler colonial societies.

Since receiving his Ph.D, Dr. Pessah has been awarded post-doctoral fellowships at the Hebrew University and at Tel Aviv University, and has taught two courses: *Ethnicity and "Race" – A Global Perspective* at the Sociology and Anthropology Department at Ben-Gurion University, and *Violence and Politics – Selected Topics* at the Rothberg School in the Hebrew University. His work has appeared in the *Ethnic and Racial Studies*, as well as in an upcoming edited volume to be published by the Van Leer Institute.
