Funding Collaborations between BGU and faculty from the Philadelphia Area

Introduction:

BGU International is pleased to announce a funding initiative designed to foster and deepen collaborations between BGU faculty and counterparts in the greater Philadelphia area. This initiative seeks to leverage the unique strengths and expertise of researchers from both regions to advance collaboration across a wide range of disciplines.

Objective:

The goal of this program is to promote innovative projects that bring together researchers from BGU and institutions in Philadelphia. By encouraging international teamwork, we aim to create opportunities for global initiatives which will jump start collaborative research and/or teaching.

Funding Details:

Grants will be awarded to joint projects for a period of one year. These funds are intended to cover expenses related to the research activities, including but not limited to travel and accommodations for meetings, workshops, joint teaching, joint experiments, and dissemination of results.

Eligibility:

- Application must be submitted by the BGU faculty member.
- Projects must involve at least one PI from BGU and one PI from a Philadelphia area institution.
- All disciplines and ideas are welcome.

Application requirements:

- 1. Project proposal & Budget plan: A short description of the project, including objectives, expected outcomes and impact. The budget request will outline the proposed use of the grant funds (up to 1.5 pages)
- 2. Letter of support from the researcher from the Philadelphia area.
- 3. Short CV of Principal investigators (PI) involved in the project.

Submission Logistics:

- 1. This offering is a combination of the Sutnick funds (Sutnick/Rosen, Sutnick/Bershad, Sutnick-Walter, Sutnick-Bursztyn Golberg & Sutnick-Zipkin) as well as the Philadelphia Chapter BGU/Fox Chase Collaborative Fund.
- 2. This call is open to faculty from all fields.
- 3. Accepting proposals for up to \$20,000.
- 4. Applications will be evaluated by a BGU committee.

Application deadline: August 30, 2024.
