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## **Course Description and Objectives**

The course aims to teach writing research proposals according to guidelines.

## **Teaching Method:**

The course will be conducted through formal lectures, class discussions, and personal meetings.

## **Course evaluation:**

This class is designed as a workshop. Therefore, class time is devoted to discussion between and among students and the instructor, as well as lectures. Grades are based on assigned papers and the Research Proposal. The composition of final grades and grading scale is as follows:

Written assignments & class presentation - 20 %

Final paper - 80%.

The document should be no more than 12 A4 pages long, excluding a title page and bibliography; double spaced; Times New Roman or Arial; font 11 or 12; and normal margins (2 cm).

Failing to submit assignments on time without receiving an extension in advance will affect the grade.
