Call for articles for a special issue on The Centenary of the British Mandate for Palestine

Proposals consisting of an abstract (no more than 400 words) should be submitted to <u>istudies@bgu.ac.il</u> no later than May 1, 2020. Notification regarding proposals will be sent by July 1, 2020. Final accepted articles are due no later than January 31, 2021 and should be no longer than 7,000 words, including an abstract, text, notes, and illustrations. All articles are peer reviewed.
