Chasing Social Spiders Across Three Continents

I did not yet have an idea for a PhD when I was offered the opportunity to spend two years as a research assistant on an expedition to Papua New Guinea. However, a first encounter with colonies of up to thousands of spiders led to both a PhD and a recurrent research theme: how can we explain the evolution and persistence of group living in these predatory and cannibalistic animals? I provide 'snapshots' of some of my quests for answers to this question.
