Faculty Scholarship for foreigner Master students

The fellowship is for 2 years (4 semesters) open for all the departments and units at the Faculty of Engineering. Candidates must first be accepted by the host department and have an advisor approved by the department.

The scholarships will be covered in the following shares: 5 portions by the Faculty Dean, 3 portions by the host department/unit and 2 portions by the advisor, total of 10 portions (3500 shekel).

The applications should be submitted to the host department by e-mail. The applications will be submitted to the Faculty Advanced Graduate Studies Committee by the host department. The scholarship will be awarded on a competitive basis.

Instructions for Submission

- 1. Application Form (see in the following) *typewritten* (handwritten applications will not be accepted)
- 2. Formal approval of the BSc degree translated into English.
- 3. Candidate CV
- 4. Three reference letters, one of the letters should be from the advisor. The reference letters should be sent directly to the host department. The letters will be joined together, by the advisor or department secretary, with the application form that was submitted by the student. All letters to be on department letter head with a logo signed.
