An old description of linguistics is the investigation of the relation between sound and meaning. How is it that mere air vibrations or squiggles on a page can convey ideas, thoughts, beliefs, feelings? In this class we will begin a consideration of this question. We will investigate what meanings are, which factors affect the meaning of an utterance, and consider the meanings of some simple linguistic constructions. The course topics include Semantics as the study of meaning, semantic inference – entailments and presuppositions, set theory, logical inference – deductive reasoning, propositional calculus, pragmatic inference – conversational implicature.
