



KLA Excellence Scholarship for PhD. students beginning their studies in electro-optics engineering

A. General

The scholarship is provided by KLA Israel to promote enrollment of excellent students to study PhD in Electro-Optics and Photonics Engineering.

One scholarship with amount of **\$8000** will be granted for one **new student** enrolling to PhD studies in **Electro-Optics Engineering** during the 2020-2021 academic year.

The scholarship will be granted based on **excellence**.

B. Conditions for submitting candidacy

The scholarship is intended for incoming student beginning his/her PhD studies in Electro-Optics and Photonics Department, School of ECE, for the 2020-2021 academic year. Candidates must submit their requests for the scholarship after registering for their PhD studies in Electro-optics engineering. Unregistered candidates will not be considered by the Scholarship Committee.

C. Criteria for the granting of a Scholarship

1. Outstanding achievements in research (including at least one significant publication during the MSc studies).
2. Proven excellence in the past.
3. Excellent grades in prior degrees.

D. Guidelines for the submission of candidacy

The request, in the form of one PDF file, must be submitted to electrop@bgu.ac.il and must include:

1. Curriculum Vitae.
2. A list of publications. Mention the impact factor (IF) and ranking of the journals in which the papers were published, if relevant.

3. List of conference papers.
4. List of submitted papers, including the abstract and the details of the journal as described above.
5. Grade sheets from the first and second degrees.
6. Names and email addresses of two referees.
7. A recommendation letter from the supervisor.

Submission deadline: 25 Oct. 2020

Obligations of Scholarship recipients

Scholarship recipients make the following commitments to the University:

- a) To complete their research work within 4 years from the date of their acceptance into the PhD. studies or, in the case of the direct track, within 5 years.
- b) In cases in which these studies are stopped before the PhD. is granted, the scholarship is to be refunded.
- c) Presenting their research at KLA offices in Israel.
