Course Description:

Aims of the module: The goal of the sexual health module is to introduce and teach basic principles and practice in sexual health.

Objectives of the module: To enable students to classify and to have basic understanding of Sexual response physiology, pathology and common clinical interventions.

Learning outcomes of the module: On successful completion of the course, the student should be able to:

- To describe normal and abnormal sexual response cycle and correlate sexual disorders with the pathological phase.
- To classify Sexual disorders and describe common treatments in clinical work.
- To describe history taking and common laboratory tests used to assess 3. sexual dysfunctions.
- To classify sexual disorders and paraphilia and describe clinical features and common treatments for each pathology.

Teaching arrangement and method of instruction: Instruction in the module is based on frontal oral lectures, clinical discussions, PBLs, and video presentations.
