We are seeking candidates who can teach clinical, diagnostic, or intervention courses relevant to the training of school psychologists or educational counselors, as well as courses of interest to a broad range of education students. A research perspective spanning more than one area and the capacity to work in an interdisciplinary environment are an advantage. Applicants must have a record of publications in refereed journals.
