Microsoft Azure is a general, open, and flexible global cloud platform supporting any language, tool, or framework - including Linux, Java, Python, and other non-Microsoft technologies. The only prerequisite is basic programming experience in some language. This one-day course is presented by specialized trainers and is geared towards research faculty, post-doctoral researchers, postgraduate students and lab engineers.
