This year, the Intergovernmental Science-Policy Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES) released the first ever Global Assessment Report on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services. In this talk I will present what is the IPBES, what is the process for

generating its reports, and how it informs the global biodiversity policy, including that of the UN Convention on Biodiversity.

I would like to use this as an entry point to a discussion on the interface between scientific knowledge, governmental biodiversity policy, and civil activism, focusing on the national level.
