Course Description: Basic clerkship in clinical neurology

Aims of the module: To teach major topics in clinical neurology

Objectives of the module: To provide basic knowledge and skills in clinical neurology, with an emphasis on inpatient care.

Learning outcomes of the module: On successful completion of the course, the student will be able to:

1. Take a adequate history of a neurologic patient
2. Performe a complete neurological physical examination
3. Pergorme a differential diagnosis of common neurological symptoms
4. Approach a patient with acute neurological disorder (acute stroke, status epilepticus, subarachnoid hemorrhage, acute meningitis)
5. Be familiar with common farmacological agents used in nervous system disorders
6. Define prevention strategies for secondary prevention of cerebrovascular disorders

Attendance regulation: Attendance mandatory

Teaching arrangement and method of instruction:

Bedside teaching: Students will have supervised rounds, will see and present patients and will be exposed to variant histopathological, electrophysiological and imaging modalities used in neurologic patients.

Frontal teaching: Short seminars (one hour) about major nervous system disorders and neuro-radiology rounds
