Michael Bar-Eli is an Emeritus Professor from Ben-Gurion University of the Negev, Beer-Sheva, Israel. He is the former Nat Holman Chair in Sports Research and the former Chair of the Business Administration Department at the Faculty of Business and Management at the Ben-Gurion University. He was also Chairperson of both the Supreme Academic Council and the Supreme Appointments (Promotion) Committee at the Academic College at Wingate, Netanya, Israel.

Bar-Eli earned degrees in psychology and sociology from universities in Israel and Germany. He has approximately 220 international publications in English and about 90 publications in Hebrew. He also provides editorial services to leading international and Israeli scientific journals.

Bar-Eli held senior psychology positions in the Israel Defense Forces, such as the chief psychologist of the Artillery Corps, and has served as a consultant in elite sports. For example, he was head psychologist of both the Israel Basketball Association and the Israel Football (Soccer) Association.

Bar-Eli has held senior positions in FEPSAC (The European Federation of Sport Psychology) and ASPASP (The Asian-South Pacific Association of Sport Psychology). His scientific work has been recognized by a number of awards, such as "Mercator Professor" at the University of Tuebingen and "Distinguished Invited Professor" at Heidelberg University, both in Germany, and "ASPASP Fellow".
